

WELCOME TO THE ANNUAL SIMSBURY FLY-IN

PLEASE TAKE A MOMENT TO READ THIS IMPORTANT INFO ABOUT PARKING AND DEPARTURE PROCEDURES

AFTER PARKING:

- If you park on the East side of the runway, walk to the show area but **do not cross the runway.**
- There is no landing/tie down fee and sign in is not required but if you'd like to make a donation at the information booth (in front of the FBO), we'd greatly appreciate it.

WHILE YOU ARE AT THE FLY-IN

- No departures before 1 PM.** This is a safety measure to assure there will be no conflict between arriving/departing aircraft.
- No smoking on the field:** avgas, dry grass and fire don't mix!
- Aircraft may not taxi to the pump until after the Fly-in. This is a safety rule to prevent taxiing through spectator areas. Portable AVGAS containers are available to borrow/fill by calling 860-335-5674

BEFORE ENGINE START AND TAXIING

- Advise a member of the ground crew (yellow/lime green vests) you intend to start.
Do not start your engine without ground crew present.
You will be directed to the run up area by wing walkers, primarily by hand signals.
- Be courteous with your prop blast.
- Prior to departure, advise your direction of flight on 122.7
- North, South, and Eastbound departures contact BDL as soon as possible after departure. Do not penetrate BDL Class C airspace without contacting BDL. Frequencies: 125.35 for North & West, 123.95 for Southwest and Northeast.
- Per FAA regulations, low passes over the runway are not permitted.**
- Have a safe flight, and thanks for attending the Simsbury Fly-In!!

The Simsbury Airport is operated by the non-profit Simsbury Flying Club. We receive no government aid, and are self-supporting. The Fly-In is a major factor in our efforts to keep this airport alive and well. Your donation will be greatly appreciated, and will help assure the continued existence of this small country airport.
